Assemble your litter-picking team.

Pick a place and time.

Find somewhere local that gets a bit messy and is easy for everyone to get to. Stick to a **Bristol location** and make sure it's safe and legal to access.

Get your kit.

You can borrow litter picking kits from Bristol Waste for free. Use the **kit booking form** on our website.

4

Stay safe.

Read our **health and safety advice** and ensure you and your litter picking team enjoy yourselves safely.

5

Take lots of photos!

Dispose of the litter you've collected.

- Take your collected litter home with you and dispose of it in your own bin.
