Bin hire for students and landlords

Before booking short term 660-litre or 1100-litre bin hire from Bristol Waste, please read the following information:



Please do:

- store the waste disposal bin on your private property on a level surface. This does not include a pavement, highway or grass
- ensure the wheels remain locked when the bin is stationary and unattended
- refer to our general Terms & Conditions at: www.bristolwastecompany.co.uk/terms-and-conditions/



Please don't:

- overfill the bin - the lid must close on collection
- fill it with overly heavy material. We need to be able to move the bin safely and efficiently on collection.

Some items cannot be put in the 660-litre or 1100-litre bin for health and safety, transportation or reuse and recycling reasons. **Please read both lists carefully.**

Acceptable



- aerosols (non-hazardous)
- audio cassettes & video tapes
- small electrical appliances & equipment
- books
- food tins, drinks cans & foil
- small car parts (drained of any fluids)
- cardboard, paper, newspaper & magazines
- CDs & DVDs
- computers (not monitors)
- food & drink cartons (including tetrapaks)
- clothes, textiles & shoes
- small items of furniture
- garden waste (10kg limit)
- small gas bottles
- glasses (spectacles)
- household black bag waste (excess)
- mobile phones
- plastics (bottles, packaging & rigid plastics)
- small items of scrap metal
- sheet glass & bottle glass (clear & coloured)
- small items of wood & timber
- bicycle parts & small bicycles

Not acceptable



- aerosols (hazardous)
 - large electrical appliances or equipment
 - batteries
 - chemicals (household or garden)
 - engine oil
 - cooking oil
 - fridges and freezers
 - computer monitors or TV's
 - fluorescent light tubes
 - printer cartridges
 - large items of furniture or mattresses
 - tyres
 - large gas bottles
 - low energy light bulbs
 - paint tin (full)
 - chemicals
 - large items of scrap metal
 - asbestos
 - large items of wood or timber
 - large whole bicycle
 - building waste
- Car batteries: may be placed by the side of the bin on collection.**
