

FLY-TIPPING DAMAGES YOUR COMMUNITY AND ENCOURAGES CRIME. DON'T RISK A £400 FINE.

WHAT IS FLY-TIPPING?

Any waste left on public or private land without permission including:

- bulky items furniture/ appliances
- bin bags of waste left next to a bin
- garden waste left on a grass verge

HOW DO WE CATCH FLY-TIPPERS?

- reports from members of the public
- enforcement team investigations
- motion-triggered cameras
- witness statements

WHAT HAPPENS IF YOU ARE CAUGHT FLY-TIPPING?

- you will be given a £400 fixed penalty
- you could also be charged with a criminal offence
- you could receive a fine for fly-tipping of up to £50,000

WARNING - if you ask someone else to take away your waste and they fly-tip it, you could still be fined.

Always use a licensed waste removal contractor.

DON'T DUMP YOUR WASTE!

Help keep Bristol clean and tidy - check below to see where your waste should go.



BULKY ITEMS

- if your item is still usable, sell it online, donate it to a charity shop or bring it to our Reuse Shops, based at the recycling centres
- take it to a recycling centre for free
- use a licensed waste removal contractor
- use our **bulky household waste collection** service (charges apply)



GENERAL WASTE AND RECYCLING

- put your household waste and recycling out for your **regular kerbside collections** (black wheelie bin/recycling boxes, bags and containers)
- take it to your shared **Mini Recycling Centre (MRC)** if you have shared bins
- take it to a recycling centre for free



BRISTOL

GARDEN WASTE

- take it to a **recycling centre** for free
- compost it at home
- use our **garden waste collection service** (charges apply)
