Key dates for the festive season

Please consult the calendar for your revised collection days in December and January. Garden waste and bulky waste collection services will be suspended after Friday 20 December and will resume Monday 20 January 2025.

Recycling your festive goods



Take your Christmas tree to your nearest recycling centre for free.

For those with Christmas tree collections, trees must be no taller than 2m and all decorations must be removed. Check your calendar for the \$\hat\$ symbol. Real trees can also be brought to your local recycling centres.



Please sort your boxes. Extra recycling or waste can be brought to the local recycling centres. Remember to book before your visit.



We can only recycle festive cards without glitter. Please put them in your blue bag with any cardboard.



Please remove tape and flatten and fold your cardboard so it fits inside your blue bag.



We are unable to collect wrapping paper to be recycled. Refer to manufacturer for recycling instructions.



Use your brown caddy for any food leftovers and help generate energy for Bristol. Visit our website to learn what can be recycled as food waste.



Batteries and fairy lights can be recycled in your black box. Place them in an untied bag inside the box.
